
has approved registration with the Department of Environmental Protection; and is thereby **authorized to transport Regulated Medical Waste.**

All regulated medical waste must be managed in an environmentally sound manner. In complying with the packaging requirements pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-3.A.11, generators must ensure that all medical waste is placed in a container or containers that are:

1. Rigid;
2. Leak-resistant;
3. Impervious to moisture;
4. Have a strength sufficient to prevent tearing or bursting under normal conditions of use and handling; and
5. Sealed to prevent leakage during transport.

In addition, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-3.A.30, the name of the transporter, the registration number, and the words "MEDICAL WASTE or INFECTIOUS WASTE" (approximately three inches in height) must be placed on both sides and back of the cargo carrying body. Please be aware that any non-compliance with the Department's transporter requirements may cause your company to be subject to severe enforcement penalties.
